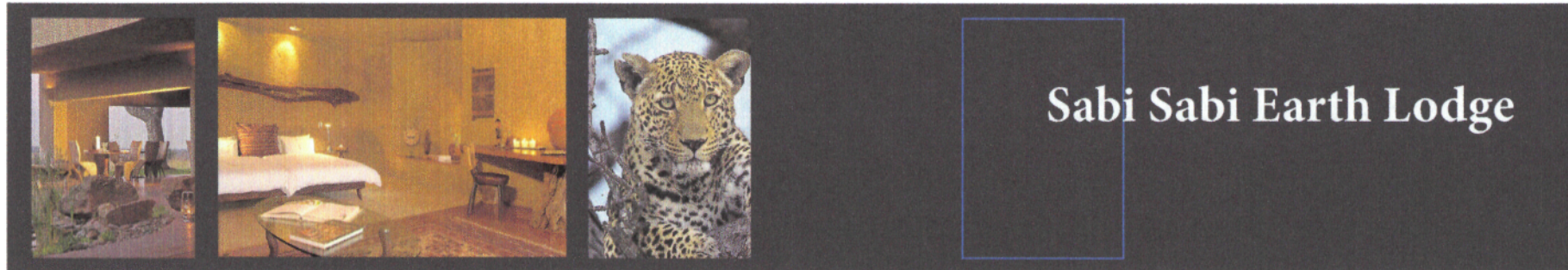
ACTIVITIES:

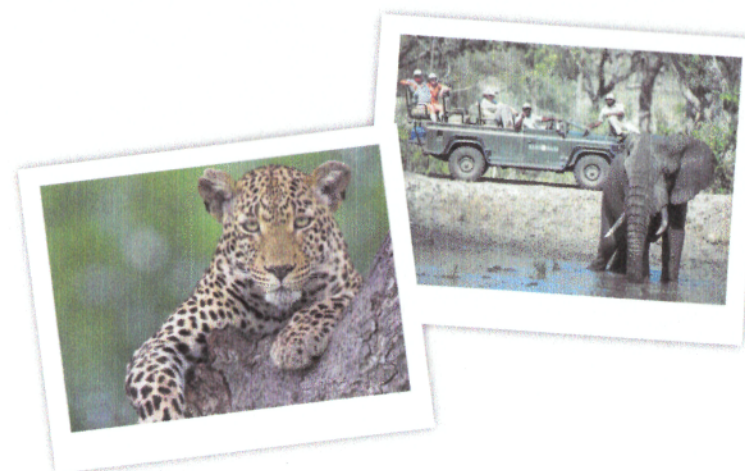
